1. Active: She writes a letter.

Passive: A letter is written by her.

2. Active: They completed the project.

Passive: The project was completed by them.

3. Active: The teacher is explaining the lesson.

Passive: The lesson is being explained by the teacher.

4. Active: He will buy a new car.

Passive: A new car will be bought by him.

5. Active: I have finished my homework.

Passive: My homework has been finished by me.

6. Active: They are watching a movie.

Passive: A movie is being watched by them.

7. Active: She was reading a book.

Passive: A book was being read by her.

8. Active: The manager had approved the report.

Passive: The report had been approved by the manager.

9. Active: We will complete the assignment tomorrow.

Passive: The assignment will be completed by us tomorrow.
